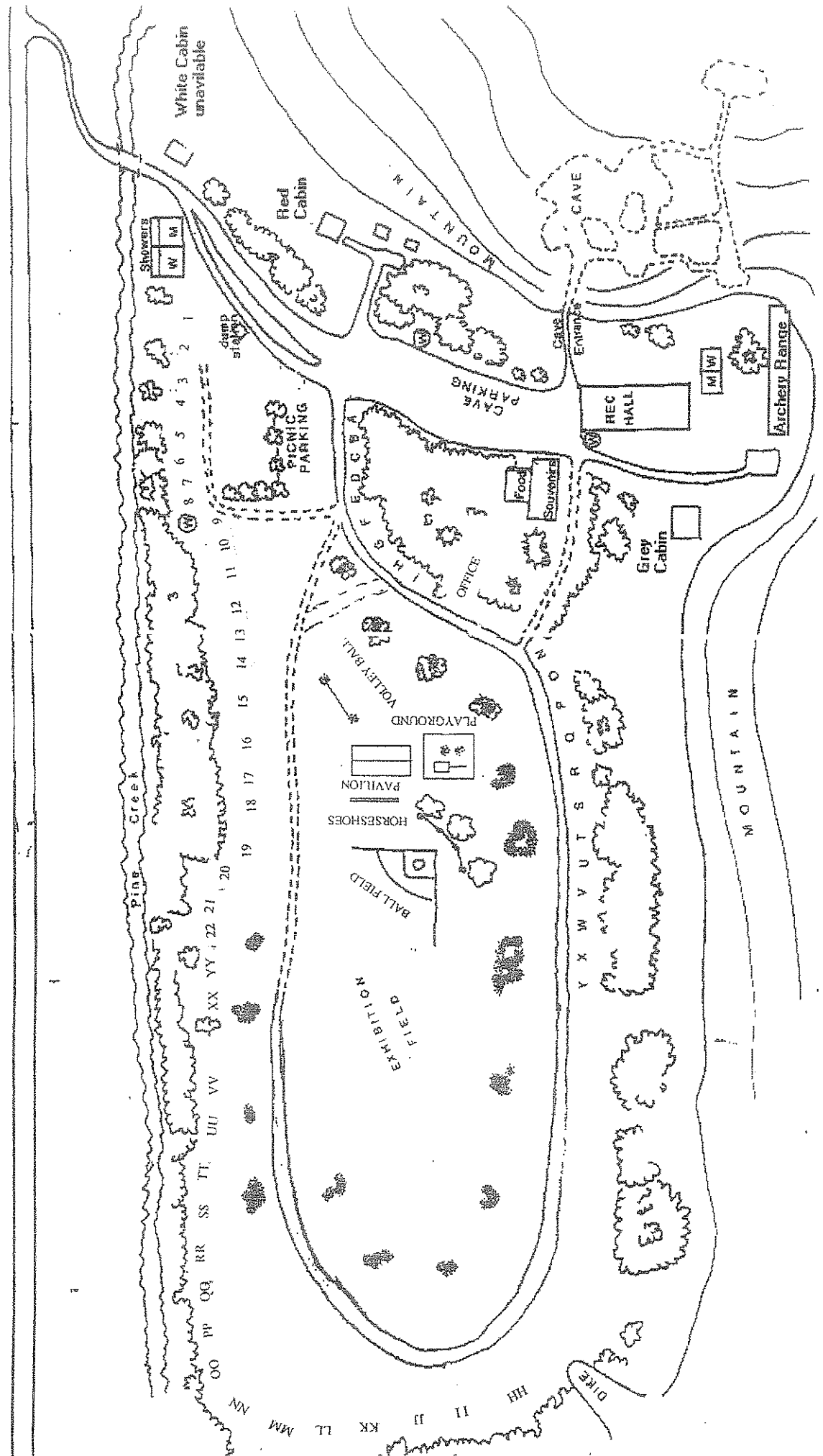

## Woodward Cave and Campground Rules

1. Quiet time begins at 10:00pm each night. Noise must not exceed the site perimeter between 10:00 pm and 9:00am. Please respect your neighbors privacy.
2. Fires must be maintained in a fire ring. We ask that you use an existing bare spot for your fire. Please burn all combustible trash safely.
3. Trashcans are provided for each site for non burnable trash. Cans designated for ALUMINUM CANS ONLY are also distributed around the campground. We ask that you put only aluminum cans in these containers as we have a Scout troop collecting these cans.
4. Only one picnic table per site unless approved by the office.
5. Any blown down limbs or branches can be used for your fire. You can purchase bundles of firewood for \$8.00.
6. Destruction of property, trees, shrubs will not be tolerated. Offenders will be charged a fine of \$50 for such acts.
7. NO playing or bicycle riding in or around the pavilion, bathroom, store, bridge or cave entrance. This is for the safety of your children. Bicycle riding can be done in the campground area only.
8. No one over the age of 13 may use the playground facilities. ALL children must be under Adult Supervision. We are not responsible for injuries of unsupervised children.
9. Pets are allowed. They are to be leashed at all times, cleaned up after, and not left unattended. If you leave for the day your pet must go with you.
10. Alcohol is allowed on your site. Please drink sensibly and responsibly. No alcohol is to be served to minors.
11. Camp site rentees are responsible for visitors fees, injuries, accidents and behaviors
12. We will allow only sparklers and on ground fireworks. NO ROCKETS, OR ANY ITEM THAT IS FIRED INTO THE AIR IS ALLOWED. IF YOU USE THESE ITEMS YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE CAMPGROUND. THIS IS FOR THE SAFETY OF YOUR FELLOW CAMPERS AS WELL AS YOU OWN SAFETY.
